Dr. Geoffrey Mills is a long standing professor of finance and economics. He has taught extensively at universities and MBA programs both in the US and abroad. He has held appointments at schools in Hong Kong, Greece, Lebanon, Dubai, and Norway, among other locations.

Dr. Mills has been awarded three Fulbright Scholarships, for academic research and international academic administration, in Denmark, Hong Kong and Japan/Korea. He has been a long time business school dean and professor, and active for nearly 30 years with AACSB – International. While at the University of Northern Iowa Dr Mills led the AACSB accreditation effort and has been a prime participant in institutional accreditation by NEASC and the North Central Association.

Dr. Mills has held administrative appointments at business schools in North Carolina, the UAE, Lebanon and Greece. A central feature of his work at these institutions has been on developing ways and means for student success, faculty development, and strategic planning.

An expert on wage and price controls, as well as wartime economic stabilization policies, Dr. Mills has published extensively on the economics of WWII, focusing on price controls as an instrument of inflation management. He has also done work on financial contagion, especially in Asia, and real estate markets.
